Net Generation of Subsidiary Power Plants in the First Five Months of 2017 Increased by 6.5%

China Resources Power Holdings Company Limited (“CR Power”, stock code: 0836) today announced that total net generation of subsidiary power plants in May 2017 increased by 4.0% to 12,046,058MWh from 11,580,097MWh for the same period of 2016. Total net generation of subsidiary power plants for the first five months of 2017 increased by 6.5% to 62,806,167MWh compared to 58,948,189MWh for the same period last year.

On a same plant basis, total net generation of subsidiary coal-fired power plants for the first five months of 2017 increased by 1.3% compared to the same period of 2016. Power plants located in Guangdong, Hubei, Hebei and Other provinces recorded 14.3%, 5.4%, 4.9% and 6.0% increases year on year, respectively. Power plants located in Henan and Jiangsu recorded 8.4% and 4.4% decreases year on year, respectively.
