Coal Production in the First Three Months of 2018 Reached 3.560 Million Tonnes

China Resources Power Holdings Company Limited (“CR Power”, stock code: 0836) today announced that total coal production in March 2018 increased by 5.6% to 1.384 million tonnes from 1.310 million tonnes for the same period last year. Total coal production for the first three months of 2018 increased by 8.2% to 3.560 million tonnes compared to 3.291 million tonnes for the same period last year.
